

New student enrolment and tuition fees

2023 Academic Year: Fees, Inclusions, Costs, and Refunds

As a private, independent school, Green School NZ is required to be financially independent of government education subsidies. The operating costs of GSNZ are recovered through the tuition fees charged for all enrolled students.

Note: Annual tuition fees have a 30-day payment term, invoiced when an offer of place is made. Tuition payments are due prior to student enrolments being confirmed

Note: A 5% discount is given to the first sibling (when there are two children in the family); a 10% discount is given to the second sibling (when there are three children in the family); and a 25% discount is given to subsequent younger siblings. In order to receive the sibling discount, all students must be enrolled at Green School for a period of at least one full year, and pay the full year tuition within 30 days of the invoice.

Direct debit must be in place for the full year for NZ termly payers, no termly paying option for AUS and INT learners.

One year commitment required for all learners, with a term's notice of withdrawal expected, and refund of fees paid in advance on exceptional grounds only, and at management discretion. Unpaid fees payable for the remainder of the year remain payable, and will be waived on exceptional grounds only, and at management discretion.

Tuition Fee Inclusions

The tuition fee is inclusive of:

- All teaching and learning activities – maximum class size is 15–20, the learner–teacher ratio is 1–10.
- All learning resources and support materials including art/design supplies, technical supplies, technology services and support.
- All curriculum–related activities and transport – including sports day, hikoi, off–campus programmes, camps, and trips such as caving, trips up the mountain etc.
- Most after school activities are also included free of charge.

Additional Costs

The following costs are the responsibility of families:

- A personal pencil case with basic stationery items
- Supply of a suitable learning device. Learners in years 7–13 will be required to bring their own device (a tablet with a keyboard or laptop)
- Sport uniform
- School lunches
- The school bus service (if space is available)
- Optional after–school activities/competitions which are delivered via an outside provider
- Where a student chooses to take classes/courses/exams outside the curriculum, additional costs may be incurred
- Some optional, experiential outward–bound programmes on offer within High School may attract an additional cost
- Additional student learning support: Where additional support is required for learners to access learning which cannot be catered for within the existing staffing models. This additional charge for support will be discussed as part of an individual learning plan and agreed in advance.

Minimum Enrolment Period

The minimum enrolment period is generally one academic year (four terms), commencing February or July. On occasions, semester enrolments may be accommodated, where there is space available within a class.

Refund Policy

Tuition fees are not refundable. The school's budget is determined based on enrolment numbers at the start of the academic year and financial commitments are made to faculty, staff and facilities investments accordingly. Therefore, requests for pro–rated tuition charges or refunds as a result of illness, unexpected departures or extended holidays cannot be granted (refer to Withdrawal of Enrolled Students).

In the event that a student is required to leave for disciplinary reasons, tuition fees are forfeited.
